Participant COVID-19 Attestation Form

To ensure the safety of athletes, officials, and spectators, we have created the below COVID-19 attestation for the Baystate Marathon and Half Marathon hosted on October 17th, 2021. The goal of this policy is to keep contagious people away from the event and limit exposure and virus spread. Athletes, race officials and race volunteers must provide proof of either vaccination or a negative COVID test result within the 72 hours prior to race day. In addition, mask wearing has been proven effective in reducing the spread of the virus. We encourage you to wear a mask in any locations where social distancing is not possible.
